PHP 1070 is a multidisciplinary course in which many topics are covered with several guest lecturers. There is a core of topics covered by lectures from the instructor. There will be a mid-term and final exam worth 15% each of the final grade. Discussion sections meet each week and 10% of the final grade is based on discussion section performance. There are required small group research projects with several deadlines during the semester worth 20% of the grade. The small group research projects help prepare students to compete for financial funding for global health experiences. There is a major term paper, 15 pages maximum length, worth 40%. This paper is the major focus of a student's intellectual growth and several dates and deadlines exist to ensure the students' progress on the paper.
